Five more businesses are moving into Progress Ridge TownSquare: hamburger restaurant **Fuddruckers**, eco-conscious children's shop **Posh Baby**, **Cornell Urgent Care**, **Brow Betty** and **Menchie's Frozen Yogurt**.

Gramor Development, the developer of the 20-acre center, announced that many of its tenants will coincide their openings with the **New Seasons Market** launch on Sept. 14.

a tour of the new store. In July, more than 1,000 people had vied for 175 positions **during a job fair** for the Progress Ridge location.
